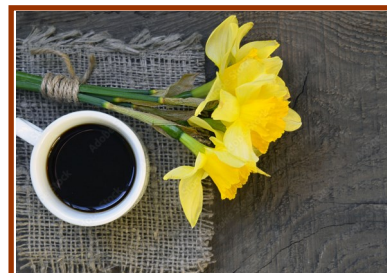

You are also invited to St Paul's Church for refreshments after the service.

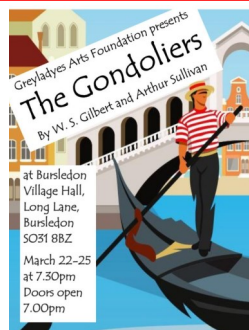
